Idaho Wine History
Idaho Wine, 150 years in the making

Idaho is considered, by some, part of the new frontier of wine growing areas in the United States. Idaho is home of over 50 wineries, with over 1,300 acres and producing over 225,967 cases of wine a year. We will be visiting Ste. Chapelle Winery it was the first Idaho winery to open after prohibition in 1976.
